Responsibilities:

 standards and align with overarching company objectives.
- Lead and inspire project teams, fostering collaboration and communication among members. Facilitate meetings with the core team, focusing on team objectives and dynamics.
- Create comprehensive project plans that identify critical milestones, interdependencies, risks, and resource constraints, working with the core team to develop effective solutions.
- Maintain and contribute to core team documentation, including meeting agendas, minutes, action items, and decision logs. Recognize potential risks and formulate mitigation strategies to ensure project success.
- Collaborate with the VP of Operations to create and maintain project budgets, ensuring efficient resource utilization within budgetary constraints.

Requirements:
